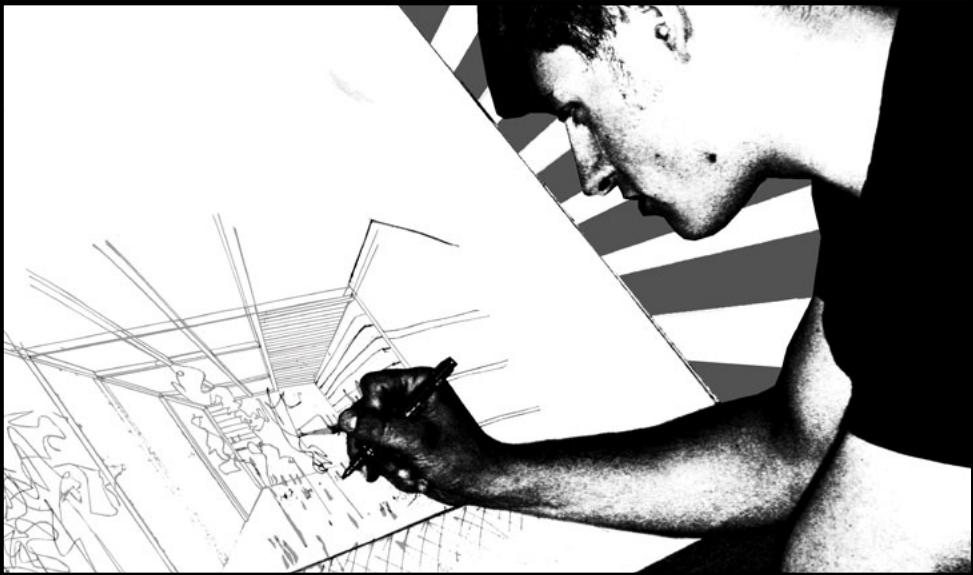

Thesis: The Healthy Community

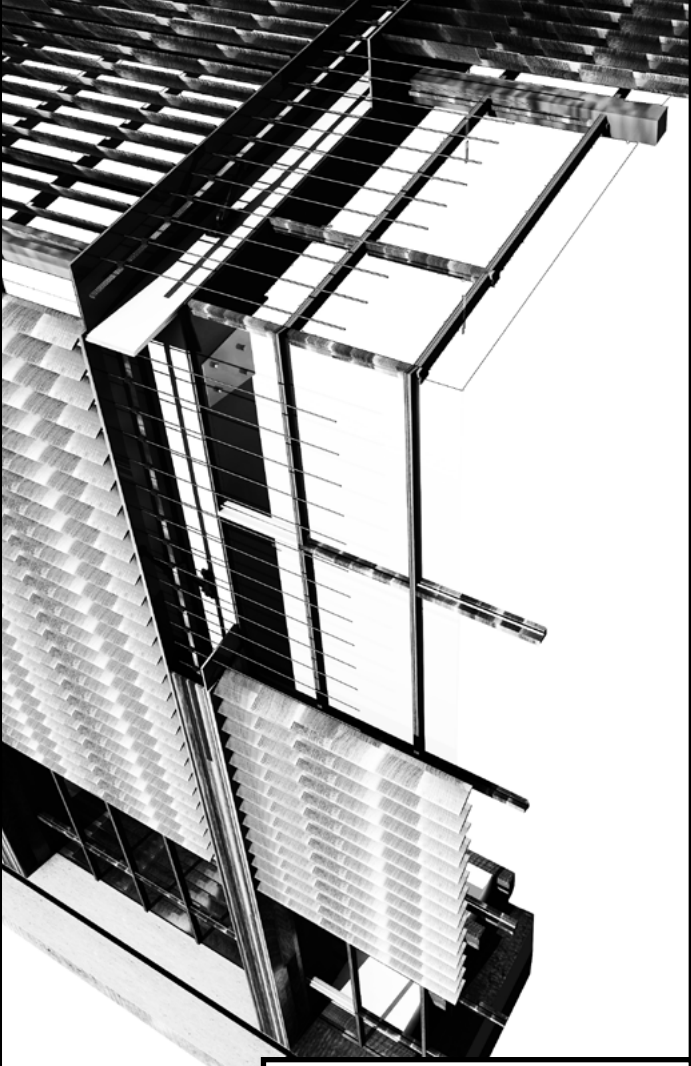
The thesis project was based in Longhill, Hull, one of the most obese, deprived areas in Britain
